EACH GROUP PLAYS A SPECIFIC ROLE IN FILTERING LYMPHATIC FLUID FROM ITS ASSOCIATED ORGANS, CONTRIBUTING TO THE OVERALL IMMUNE RESPONSE OF THE BODY. - **ANTIBODY PRODUCTION:** B CELLS DIFFERENTIATE INTO PLASMA CELLS THAT PRODUCE ANTIBODIES TO NEUTRALIZE PATHOGENS.
