THIS PROCESS NOT ONLY REFLECTS THE FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES OF AMERICAN DEMOCRACY BUT ALSO EMPHASIZES THE NEED FOR A BALANCED APPROACH TO GOVERNANCE. EACH STEP IN THE RATIFICATION PROCESS IS DESIGNED TO PREVENT HASTY DECISIONS THAT MAY NOT REFLECT THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE OR THE STATES.
